To apply for RPL the following must be supplied:

<u>For Religious Education</u> - Students who have been professional religious educators for four or more years may be eligible for up to 20 credit points in Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Applicants for RPL must submit a performance portfolio and letter of support from their employer which demonstrates how their work relates to the following Course Specific Graduate Outcomes:

- 1. The ability to demonstrate a high level of creativity in critical reflection on, and practice in, religious education.
- 2. An advanced level of understanding of the relationship between religious education, spirituality, and other curriculum areas.
- 3. Clear communication of a vision for religious education, underpinned by robust academic work, to professional and non-professional audiences.

<u>For Leadership and Theology</u> - Students who have held a leadership position, as specified in the admission requirements, for two or more years may be eligible for up to 40 credit points in Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Applicants for RPL must submit a performance portfolio and letter of support from their employer which demonstrates how their work relates to the following Course Specific Graduate Outcomes:

- 1. The ability to demonstrate a high level of skill in the leadership of self, others, systems, and learning.
- 2. Clear communication of complex ideas related to leadership and theology to a variety of professional and non-professional audiences, including by using new and emerging technologies.
- 3. A capacity to work autonomously and collaboratively, and with a willingness to take responsibility for their own work.

Applications for RPL will be assessed in accordance with the Credit Transfer Policy and Procedures and the Recognition of Prior Learning Policy.
